



## STAR MAZDA CHAMPIONSHIP RACER DAVID OSTELLA MAKES THE NEXT STOP ON THE 'ROAD TO INDY' WITH 2011 INDY LIGHTS PROGRAM FIELDIED BY JENSEN MOTORSPORT

Jensen MotorSport has announced the signing of talented young Canadian Star Mazda Championship racer David Ostella to a long-term contract that will include driving one of the team's Firestone Indy Lights cars in the 2011 championship season.



Canada based Jensen MotorSport has a long storied history in North American open-wheel racing. During the past 15 years, the team has competed in championships including Firestone Indy Lights, the Atlantic Championship and Formula BMW Americas.
