

2012 Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear Announces Four-Race Winter Series to Take Place Over Two Weekends at Two California Racetracks

Sonoma, CA / September 21, 2013 -- The Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear sixth annual winter championship opens in early November. The competition starts with an exclusive



NASA double header race weekend on November 10th and 11th at Infineon Raceway in Sonoma. From there the series heads to a double header during the SCCA SoPac Super Tour at Auto Club Speedway in Fontana on January 26th and 27th.

"We are very pleased to be able to provide the opportunity for drivers and teams to prepare for the 2013 season with an organized winter championship," explained series official Ben Hettema. "Since the opening races coincide with the finale weekend of our regular season we already know that we have a good number of drivers signed up for the opening weekend. This is a great place for drivers and teams to get started as they gear up for next season.

In the past many teams including Andretti Autosport, World Speed Motorsports, Richie Hearn Racing, Goshen Motorsports, GDT, Phenom Racing Group, John Walko Racing, and Team Apex have joined our usual west coast based racers in preparation for their upcoming seasons." Jorge Goncalvez, who won the FCC Winter Championship in 2009 finished 5th in points in the Indy Lights championship in 2011. Last year's Pro FM class Winter Series Champion Zach Veach is currently in the top ten in the 2012 Star Mazda championship, and has tested in the Andretti Indy Lights program.

"In the past many Star Mazda teams have joined our usual west coast based racers in preparation for their upcoming seasons," noted Series Official Ben Hettema. "Race entry is inexpensive, there is no series entry fee, and we have four races over two weekends which makes this a very cost effective way to stay sharp in the 'off' season."
