

NICK HAYE AND JDC MOTORSPORTS REUNITE IN STAR MAZDA CHAMPIONSHIP

January 18, 2007 Lakeville, MN,----JDC MotorSports announced today the signing of 19-year-old former F2000 driver, Nick Haye, to compete in the 2007 Star Mazda Championship. Just named as one of EFCN Top-10 Formula 2000 drivers, Haye is expected to be a top contender in the Star Mazda Series. Haye impressed the team with his abilities in a recent one day test at Sebring International Raceway. “It was really great to be back working with everybody at JDC. The team and I have good chemistry and I can’t wait to get back in the car for more testing,” said Haye.

“We are extremely happy to have Nick on board again for the 2007 Championship,” said team co-owner, John Church. “Nick had a solid run at Sebring – his first day in the car and his first time at Sebring. We are looking forward to the opportunity to get him some additional seat time prior to the season opener.” Haye who ran with the JDC MotorSports team during the 2005 F2000 Cooper Series spent the 2006 season refining his skills in the F2000 Pacific Series.

Haye, recounting his experience of the one-day Sebring test said, “I came up to speed quickly and used the first half of the day to get familiar with the car. I spent the second half of the day working on improving my lap times and was really making progress by the end of the day.”

JDC MotorSports will be testing additional drivers in February. JDC MotorSports also competes in the F2000 Championship Series in an effort to continue to help develop young, up and coming drivers within their own team.
