This unfortunate turn of events moved him back to 16th before earning back several positions as the checkered flag dropped. "I've been struggling with some issues the last two races, but I have worked through the problems. I'm really ready to take on the field in Toronto and go full-on for the remainder of the series," commented Haye.

Gerry Kraut, driving the #55 JDC MotorSports/Dougherty Funding/Redline Oil Star Mazda, ran a steady, heads-up race crossing the checker in 15th place earning him the top spot for the Masters drivers. "This was another great weekend for Gerry, he is really coming to grips with the car and improving each weekend," commented team co-owner John Church.
