## Caldwell Announces 2008 Mazda Pro Events

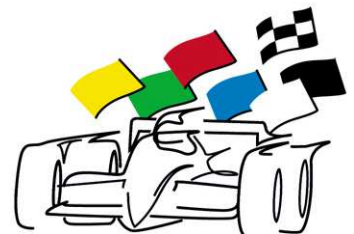
