

## Patrick O'Neill joins Mundill for 2009 Star Mazda season

Last year O'Neill won the West Coast Star Mazda Championship.

With the pre-season testing program already commenced, Mundill's focus is towards the season opener that will be held at Sebring International Raceway in Florida on March 20. The Star Mazda Championship features 13 races over 11 weekends, racing on Ovals, Street, and Road courses.
