# ZACH VEACH ADDED TO ANDRETTI AUTOSPORT'S STAR MAZDA LINEUP AT SONOMA, LAGUNA SECA

## Veach to join Sage Karam for two race events in addition to challenging for USF2000 championship title

**INDIANAPOLIS (Aug. 18, 2011)** – Andretti Autosport announced today it has added driver Zach Veach to its Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear lineup at Infineon Raceway and Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca. Veach will drive the #77 Team Zakosi Data Backup car for the two events, joining the team's full-time entrant Sage Karam for a two-car effort.

Veach currently competes in the Cooper Tires Presents the USF2000 National Championship Powered by Mazda with Andretti Autosport and will continue his quest for the championship title at Road America and the Streets of Baltimore, in addition to his time in the Star Mazda machine. Veach has secured three USF2000 pole positions and one race win, along with eight top-10 finishes, putting him in third place in championship points.

In early 2011, Veach also competed in the Cooper Tires Presents the USF2000 Winterfest Championship, a special five-race series, and captured the championship title with two race wins and three pole positions. Veach finished fifth in the overall 2010 USF2000 driver championship points, despite starting the season two races behind the rest of the field. He secured eight top-five finishes throughout the season, helping Andretti Autosport clinch the team championship title.

Zakosi Data Backup, sponsor for the #77 car, offers fast, affordable, secure, managed and unmanaged online data backup to small to medium-sized businesses. In addition to Zakosi, Retail Pro, ArtRotondo.com, ADS IT Solutions, Arai Helmets and OMP Racing are also partners on the #77 effort.

Sanctioned by INDYCAR, the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear is one of two series part of both the Mazda Road to Indy ladder system and the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development driver program. Veach will compete in two of the final three 2011 Star Mazda events, at Infineon Raceway in Sonoma, Calif. on Aug. 27 and Mazda Raceway at Laguna Seca on Sept. 18.

Zach "Ziggy" Veach is a 16-year-old autoracing driver who competes in INDYCAR's 'Mazda Road to Indy' USF2000 National Championship Series, an important open-wheel stepping-stone to a career in the IZOD IndyCar Series and Indianapolis 500. In 2011, Veach captured the USF2000 Cooper Tires Winterfest Championship, on the heels of placing fifth in the 2010 season, despite missing two race events. In 2010, Michael Andretti signed Veach to his team, Andretti Autosport, while Veach was also being named one of CNN's "Intriguing People" and was also nominated for Sports Illustrated "Sports Kid of the Year" award. In addition to his racing, Veach is an advocate for safer driving in conjunction with Oprah Winfrey's "No Phone Zone," and is the national spokesperson for FocusDriven, an advocacy group for victims of motor vehicle crashes involving drivers using their cell phones. In 2010, Veach released his first published Android application through his phone-app building company, ZaAPP, releasing urTXT, in the Marketplace for Android to help consumers avoid dangerous text messaging while driving and helms his own safe driving program, Ziggy's Safe Driving, which hits 25 markets across the country each year. Veach has been a quest or profiled on a variety of national platforms including NBC's The Today Show, CNN's Headline News, ABCNews.com, Oprah Radio's The Gayle King Show, The Los Angeles Times, AOL.com and is a blogger for RACER magazine.
