Scuncio Qualifies 2nd for Race #1 at Barber – Race #1 Rained Out

Birmingham, AL (March 30, 2012) –Juncos Racing’s Martin Scuncio qualified second in the rain for Race #1 at Barber Motorsports Park in the chase for the 2012 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear. Rain washes out Race #1, moving the race to Sunday.

Scuncio, 20, qualified the #22 Pullman Bus Juncos Racing car second with a time of 1:29:822 (92.182 mph) for the second time this season, previously qualifying second in St. Petersburg.

“I am really happy to qualify as well as I did today in the rain,” said Scuncio. “We are going to continue to work hard and hopefully pull off a win on Sunday. I want to thank the team for all they have done to get me in the front row for Race #1.”

Juncos Racing drivers Connor De Phillippi, 19, in the #2 ModSpace Juncos Racing car qualified fourth, rookie Bruno Palli in the #15 TeamViso Venezuela qualified eighth and Diego Ferreira, 18, driving the #57 TeamViso Venezuela qualified 13th for Race #1 Sunday.

The Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear will continue Sunday with Friday’s Race #1 due to rain has been moved to Sunday April 1st at 11:20AM EST and Race #2 will start following the IZOD INDYCAR race. Live timing and scoring will be available via
