### **Juncos Racing completes Lucas Oil Raceway Test**

Brownsburg, IN (May 5, 2012) – Juncos Racing drivers for the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear ended the day at Lucas Oil Raceway with all drivers finishing inside the Top 10.

De Phillippi, 19, driving the #2 ModSpace Motorsports/Juncos Racing car finished his day sixth overall in both sessions with a best time of 20.581 (119.994 mph).

“Today was a productive day of testing with the team,” said De Phillippi. “We are still working on improving many areas of the car to put it up front for the race this month. A big thank you to Juncos Racing and ModSpace Motorsports for getting me on track. Now we are onwards and upwards for the Night Before the 500.”

Ferreira, 18, in the #57 Team Viso Venezuela/Juncos Racing car finished strong his first time at Lucas Oil Raceway eighth overall with a time of 20.718 (119.201 mph).

“I’m very happy with how we finished the day,” said Ferreira. “I am adapting to the car fast and feel comfortable with the ovals after only two tests. We are going to continue to work on the car and continue to improve as the month moves on.”

Scuncio, 20, in the #22 Pullman Bus/Juncos Racing car ended the day tenth with a time of 20.809 (118.679 mph).

Palli, 20, driving the #15 Team Viso Venezuela/Juncos Racing car completed his first time at Lucas Oil Raceway just outside the Top 10 with the 11<sup>th</sup> quickest time, 20.819 (118.622 mph) overall for the day.

“I’m thrilled after only my second time on an oval finishing the day out strong like we did,” said Palli. “We made a lot of improvements from the first session into the second session. I am excited for my first race on an oval this month and want to thank my team, Team Viso Venezuela and everyone else for their support.”

Ricardo Juncos, Team Owner, is pleased with the overall results of his Star Mazda drivers at Lucas Oil Raceway and looks forward to moving the cars upfront at The Night Before the 500 at the end of this month.

“We had a great end to our day at Lucas Oil Raceway finishing all drivers within the Top 10,” said Juncos.” “We made a lot of changes throughout the day to give our drivers fast cars. The team still has improvements to make, but I feel confident we will finish the month out strong with podium finishes for Juncos Racing. Thank you to the team, sponsors, and my family, for continuing to work hard and show all of their support.”
