Juncos Racing Back on Track at Trois-Rivieres

Trois-Rivieres, Quebec, Canada (August 3, 2012) – After a tough break in July at Toronto and Edmonton, Juncos Racing qualified all cars inside the Top-10 for 43rd Annual GP3R in the battle for the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear.

Connor De Phillippi, 19, driving the ModSpace Motorsports One24/Juncos Racing car qualified .042 seconds off of the pole today and will start Race #1 in second position. Martin Scuncio, 20, driving the #22 Pullman Bus/Juncos Racing car ran a tight qualifying session and will start tomorrow's race in fifth position.

Rookie Diego Ferreira, 18, in the #57 Team Viso Venezuela/Juncos Racing qualified ninth and teammate Rookie Bruno Palli, 20, in the #15 Team Viso Venezuela/Juncos Racing car will start just outside in 10th position.

Ricardo Juncos, Team Owner, feels his team has a strong overall starting position with all cars qualifying within the Top-10 and looks to get his team back at the top of the championship.

"We are finally getting the cars back to the front where they should be after a tough few races this past month," said Juncos. "The team has worked long hours to get these cars back up to where they should be and it showed today. We have a tough battle to get back into the championship, but I am confident that we will get back to where we need to be this weekend."
