

ALEX ARDOIN QUICKEST IN PRACTICE 1 FOR THIS WEEKEND'S ROUND THREE OF THE STAR MAZDA CHAMPIONSHIP AT MILLER MOTORSPORTS PARK



In last year's Star Mazda Championship race weekend at Miller Motorsports Park, Louisiana racer Alex Ardoin brought new meaning to the old country western lament "If it weren't for bad luck, I'd have no luck at all."

His luck was so bad that he didn't qualify and started the race from the last position in the field, 29th. At this point talent took over and he was able to power his way through the field to finish 10th, and it appears that momentum is still with him as he set – by a comfortable margin – the quickest time in this morning's first practice session at the wheel of his #51 JDC Motorsports / Oral & Facial Surgery Center Mazda. The 1:44.642 (104.860 mph) lap is still considerably slower than the record, set in 2008 by series champion John Edwards, of 1:43.650. However, it was more than 8/10ths of a second faster than Sebring winner Adam Christodoulou's best lap of 1:45.478 (104.029) in the #11 JDC Motorsports Mazda. Third

fast was 2008 Star Mazda Championship runner-up Joel Miller, who turned a 1:46.198 (103.324 mph) in the #2 JDC Motorsports / Fader Higher Productions / Mockett / Burns Truck & Trailer Mazda.

"We tested really well here a week and a half ago, so the car was fantastic right from the first lap," said Ardoin. "The JDC crew does an amazing job and the car was even better than I expected. The track is better that I expected, really smooth, though I have noticed there's some sealer down in turns 5 and 6, so that changes how you transition on and off the surface. It's supposed to warm up this weekend, so the next session later this afternoon should give us a better feel for what the track will be like during the race."

On-track activities for drivers in the Star Mazda Championship begins with a pair of 50-minute promoter test sessions on Thursday, May 14, one beginning at 8:00 am and the other at 1:00 pm. A pair of official 45-minute practice sessions will take place on Friday, May 15 at 8:45 am and 1:00 pm. Qualifying to set the grid for the Star Mazda Championship's spectacular, F1-style standing start takes place from 8:35 am - 9:20 am Saturday, May 16, with the 45-minute Round 3 of the 2009 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear at Miller Motorsports Park during the Larry H. Miller Dealerships Utah Grand Prix Presented by the Grand & Little America Hotels scheduled to get the green light at 6:05 pm Saturday afternoon.
