ANDERS KROHN FASTEST IN FRIDAY MORNING STAR MAZDA PRACTICE MOSPORT

Mosport Raceway (August 27, 2010) - Norwegian racer Anders Krohn, 4th-quick in yesterday's promoter test sessions behind Tristan Vautier, Connor De Phillippi and Conor Daly, showed some muscle this



morning with the quickest time of the first of two official practice session. He was the only driver 'in the 15s' with a lap of 1:15.891 (116.646 mph) in the #47 Andersen Racing / Norse Cutting & Abandonment / Trallfa / Colosseum Mazda. Krohn is currently second in the championship battle behind Conor Daly and is Daly's only remaining competition for the 2010 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear.

As he was yesterday, Californian Connor De Phillippi was 2nd-guick with a lap of 1:16.396 (115.875 mph) in the #11 JDC Motorsports / MAZDASPEED Motorsports / Skip Barber Mazda. De Phillippi is the 2009 Skip Barber Pro Series champion who is racing this season in Star Mazda with funding provided by the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Driver Development Ladder. He scored the first podium finish of his Star Mazda career last weekend at Road America. Third quick was French racer Vautier, winner of two races so far this season. Vautier, who is currently 6th in the championship standings, turned a lap of 1:16.447 (115.798 mph) in his #38 Andersen Racing / Moulin TP / Cecibon / Circuit du Laquais / Fontanel Mazda.

There will be one final Star Mazda practice sessions at 12:45 pm today. Qualifying for the race takes place at 8:00 am Saturday, August 28, with the traditional Star Mazda F1-style 'standing start' getting the green light at 1:15 pm Saturday afternoon. This is Round 12 of the 13-race 2010 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear, and is Round 6 of the VISITFLORIDA Cup, a 7-race championship-within-achampionship sponsored by the series' television partner, VISIT FLORIDA, the official tourism and marketing organization for the state of Florida. The live HDnet broadcasts and global syndication package made possible by the VISITFLORIDA partnership brings Star Mazda Championship racing to more than 150 million households worldwide.
