

## ANDERS 'THE VIKING' KROHN QUICKEST IN FIRST DAY OF STAR MAZDA CHAMPIONSHIP TESTING FOR FRIDAY'S 2010 SEASON-ENDING ROUND 13 OF AT THE 13TH ANNUAL PETIT LE MANS AT ROAD ATLANTA

Road Atlanta / Sept. 28, 2010 - Norwegian racer Anders 'The Viking' Krohn (right), currently second in the



2010 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear points battle, set the quick time in the first of today's two incident-free practice sessions at Road Atlanta with a lap of 1:19.256 (115.373 mph) in his #47 Andersen Racing / Norse Cutting & Abandonment / Trallfa / Colosseum Mazda. He was one of only two drivers in the morning session in the 19s', the other being Frenchman Tristan Vautier (left), a 2-race winner currently 5th in the championship with a lap of 1:19.801 (114.585 mph).

Perhaps the most interesting time of the first session, however, was the 3rd-fast time of 1:20.428 (133.692 mph)set by Argentine racer Martin Scuncio, a regular in the USF2000 series making his first-ever Star Mazda Championship start at Petit Le Mans driving the #60 Juncos Racing / Fuerza Chile Mazda. His only previous experience with the car came at a team test earlier in the week, of which he quite apparently made the most.

"Juncos is a really good team and helped me get familiar with the car very quickly," said the young driver from Bahia Blanca. "The Star Mazda car is much quicker and handles very differently from the F2000 car, so I'm happy to be quick early in the practice. I don't have any particular plan for the race, just try to finish and learn as much as I can for next year... if we can get a sponsor."

Conor Daly, who clinched the 2010 Star Mazda championship with a win from the pole in Round 12 at Mosport (bringing his record to seven wins and nine poles) spent the day working with his teammates in an effort to help Juncos Racing win the team championship. As a result, he was 8th fast in the morning session and 3rd fast in the afternoon driving his #22 Juncos Racing / INDECK / The College Network / Merchant Services Ltd. Mazda.

The quick time in the afternoon was set by Los Angeles racer Connor De Phillippi (right), currently leading the heated battle for 'Rookie of the Year' honors. His lap of 1:19.309 was less than a tenth slower than the morning, but he was one of seven drivers in the 19s driving his #11 JDC Motorsports / **MAZDASPEED** Motorsports / Skip Barber Mazda. Again second was Vautier with a lap of 1:19.539, followed by Conor Daly at 1:19.562.



The Star Mazda Championship lap record at Road Atlanta is 1:18.328, set by Irish Racer Peter Dempsey, who is making his debut in this weekend's ALMS race driving a Radical LMP2 for Libra Racing.

The quickest Master Series driver (age 45 and older) was Dom Bastion of West Palm Beach, who turned a lap in the afternoon session of 1:22.082 (111.401 mph) in the #37 Andersen Racing Mazda. The fastest Expert Series driver (ages 30-44) was Texan J.W. Roberts, who has already clinched the Expert Series championship, who turned a lap of 1:22.116 (111.355 mph) in the #65 Team GDT / General Data Tech Mazda.
