



Barber Parking, Pit Lane and Schedule

We all are aware of the challenges we are faced with Parking, and pit lane at Barber, this is amplified with the additional Rolex cars, and CTSCC cars.

Per the schedule we have agreed to split Friday and Saturday with these series in order to help congestion in the pits. Rolex Practice and Qualifying Friday AM, Indycar and FIL Practice Friday PM Qualifying Sat AM, Rolex and CTSCC Race Sat PM.

Here are some points about parking and pit lane for the weekend:

We will start parking Team Transporters Tuesday evening, from 6 – 8 p.m. or wait until Wednesday afternoon, after 4 p.m.

2:00 PM on Wednesday. The order of parking will be determined as needed to fit everyone in and maximize the space available, other factors are the need for some teams to stay and work on Monday.

No lift gates down, or tents are to be setup until all transporters are parked, or ordered by an Indycar official.

All lift gates need to be kept in the upper position when not in use.

No tents or extensions are to be past the solid white line in order to keep the fire lane open.

Pit Fuel Tanks **ONLY** to Pit Lane Thursday morning. **No other equipment will be placed in pit lane until Friday following Rolex Practice at 11:15AM.**

Fill Pit Tanks for Practice Thursday starting at 9:00 AM.

Rolex Teams will be setting up their Fuel Tanks Friday post Practice, or early Saturday morning. Please make sure they communicate where in your pit they need to be setup.

Each team will need to work with the Rolex team in their respective pit to insure you each have an understanding of what space is needed and expected. All Indycar equipment will be moved back out of the pits post Indycar qualifying, as a team gets eliminated from qualifying, you will need to expedite moving your equipment as soon as possible. Teams in the Firestone Fast 6 will need to be especially helpful with moving their equipment.

All Indycar Tanks need to be taken to the fuel area to be drained post qualifying.

Space to store equipment in the paddock is very limited, please try to keep your equipment confined in your transporter area, there will be room for your Fuel tanks at fuel services area.

Indycar equipment can be placed in the pit lane post the Rolex Race late evening on Saturday, or early Sunday Morning.

Fuel tanks will be tech and filled for the race at 6:00 AM Sunday.
