Re: Radio license paperwork for Canadian races

Note: It is important that you print the attached form out, fill it out and give it to Mark Rodrigues before you leave St. Pete / this will also be posted on the series' web site.

Good Morning 2011 Mosport Participant; I will be the main contact, representing Industry Canada, for this event. In Canada, the coordination of radio frequencies and radio systems is managed by Industry Canada Spectrum Management, under the authority of the Radiocommunication Act. If you are planning to install and operate a radio system, including wireless - radio frequency devices at this year's Mosport races and do not already hold radio station licences issued by the Minister of Industry for the races, the following guidelines are provided:

- Upon the submission of a completed application/spreadsheet along with the appropriate radio licence fees, the Toronto District Office of Industry Canada (see address above) will issue a **Short Term Authority** in advance, for the installation and operation of radio systems during the event.
- The information provided in your application/spreadsheet must be accurate and complete in order that we may co-ordinate and evaluate the radio frequencies to be used during the race, thereby minimizing the possibility of interference between radio systems.

Please submit your application/spreadsheet and at least one month prior to the event to allow us the maximum time to process your frequency request before commencing operation. Please note that the installation or operation of radio apparatus without authority is prohibited under Section 4 of the Radiocommunication Act.
