





KARAM DOMINATES HEATED STAR MAZDA CHAMPIONSHIP TESTING BATTLE DURING FRIDAY PRACTICE FOR THIS WEEKEND'S MOBIL1 GRAND PRIX

Mosport International Raceway / July 22, 2011 – If yesterday was about hot and cold, and produced a split decision on who was quickest, today, with a single, mid-day on-track session for the Star Mazda



Championship drivers, it was the last seven minutes that told the tale and gave Sage Karam the quickest time in three of the four testing sessions so far. Karam, the 2010 USF2000 champion and Mazda Road to Indy Scholarship driver won the last two races, both on ovals, but has left no doubt about his road racing chops with a lap of 1:16.119 in his #88 Andretti Autosport / MAZDASPEED / Comfort Revolution Mazda. This is less than 1/10th off Tristan Vautier's quick time in the relative cool of yesterday morning; a 1:16.070 set in the #5 JDC Motorsports / Cecibon / Circuit du Laquais Mazda.

Second in today's session was Connor De

Phillippi, who turned a 1:16.266 in the Team Pelfrey / Justice Brothers Products / Trademark Garage Floors Mazda. De Phillippi was the 2009 Skip Barber Pro Series champion and was the Mazda Road to Indy scholarship driver during the 2010 Star Mazda season. He, like Karam, has won two races this year, the season-opener at the Grand Prix of St. Petersburg and Round 3 on the oval at Lucas Oil Raceway. Rounding out the top-3 was De Phillippi's Team Pelfrey teammate, Nick Andries, with a lap of 1:16.404 in the #81 Team Pelfrey / Lithionics Battery / GS610 Brake Fluid / Trademark Garage Floors Mazda.

Following a lengthy yellow toward the end of the session, the field took the green with seven minutes to go and the heated battle for the top spot on the time sheet succeeded only in producing several spectacular jumps up through the field to temporarily hold the second-quick spot. With 2:30 remaining, Brazilian racer J.V. Horto moved into second, but ultimately finished 4th with a lap of 1:16.492 in the #18 Juncos Racing / Programa Leilões Mazda. Andries moved up into second with 30 seconds left to go before being eclipsed by his teammate on the final lap.

Finishing 4th-quick was Chilean racer Martin Scuncio with a 1:16.708 in his #60 Juncos Racing / Bia Comunicaciones / Cable Del Pacifico Mazda, followed by Gustavo Menezes with a 1:16.717 in the #28 Juncos Racing / Truecar / Safety Park Mazda. Menezes, the international karting champion who jumped

directly to Star Mazda competition this year, held third spot until the closing minutes of the session. The quickest driver in the Expert Series for racers 30 and older was Walt Bowlin, who turned a lap of 1:20.937 in his #23 AIM Autosport / Tampa Bay Jaw Surgery Mazda.
