









ZACH VEACH TOPS THE TIME SHEET FOR THE FIRST TIME IN STAR MAZDA PRACITCE 1 AT INDY TORONTO

Toronto, Canada / July 6, 2012 – Rookie Zach Veach, driving the #77 Andretti Autosport / K12 / Zakosi Data Backup Mazda, set the quick time in Star Mazda Practice 1 for this weekend's Indy Toronto with a lap of



1:10.584. This is Veach's first trip to the top of the time sheets this season, though he has a podium finish at the Night Before the 500 on the Lucas Oil Raceway oval and is 9th in the points.

"The ovals were pretty good to us, but I'm happy to be back on a street circuit, particularly this one," says native of Stockdale, Ohio who is still in high school. "Most street circuits, like St. Pete and Baltimore are pretty much stop-and-go, but his course flows more; I think it suits my driving style better and I'm looking forward to a good result here."

Second on the time sheet was Veach's Andretti Autosport teammate, Sage Karam, winner of the last Star Mazda event on the Iowa Speedway oval, with a lap of 1:10.616 in the #88 Andretti Autosport / Comfort Revolution Mazda. Third was Petri Suvanto, the 2011 USF2000 champion who is racing in Star Mazda this

season with scholarship funding from the Mazda Road to Indy; he turned a lap of 1:10.718 in the #81 Team Pelfrey / Mazda Road to Indy Mazda.

Rounding out the top-5 were Martin Scuncio, third in points and winner of Race 2 at Barber Motorsports Park; he turned a lap of 1:10.962 in the #22 Juncos Racing / Pullman Bus Mazda. Fifth was current championship points leader Connor De Phillippi with a lap of 1:11.088 in the #2 Juncos Racing / ModSpace Racing / One24 Mazda.

Returning to the 2.84-kilometer, 11-turn street circuit for the first time since 2007 – a race won by Dane Cameron, who went on to win the series championship – the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear heads into a run of three straight Canadian street races – beginning with this weekend's Toronto Indy.

This weekend's 5th weekend of the 2012 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear will include rounds 7 & 8 of a 10-weekend, 17-race 2012 schedule that includes a well-rounded menu of ovals, street circuits and natural-terrain road courses. Most, such as the Indy Toronto, are with IndyCar and most are double-headers with two races per weekend and the quickest lap of each car in Race 1 setting the grid for Race 2. Star Mazda uses standing starts on street circuits and road courses. This is the first of three





























Canadian races in a row, followed by Indy Edmonton on July 21 – 22, and then by the legendary GP3R Grand Prix de Trois-Rivieres, August 3 – 4, where Star Mazda will share the stage with Indy Lights.

On-track Star Mazda action continues with a second 30-minute practice session from 1:05 – 1:35 pm this afternoon. Star Mazda drivers from eight different countries and three continents will qualify for Race 1 from 8 - 8:30 am Saturday, July 7, with Race 1 scheduled for 12:10 - 12:50 pm Saturday afternoon. Star Mazda Race 2 will take place 9:50 – 10:30 am, Sunday, July 8.
