SAGE KARAM QUICK IN STAR MAZDA FRIDAY MORNING PRACTICE FOR THIS WEEKEND'S ROUND 8 AT THE GRAND PRIX OF BALTIMORE

Baltimore, Inner Harbor / August 31, 2012 – Sage Karam, who finished second here last year and went on to win 'Rookie of the Year,' set the quick time in the first practice session for this weekend's Round 8 of the



2012 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear. His lap of 1:28.8 in the #88 Andretti Autosport / Comfort Revolution Mazda was unrecorded by timing and scoring due to the failure of his car's transponder, which had its power lead shaken loose by the huge bump over the railroad tracks on the back straight. His time was verified by viewing footage from his on-board Replay XD camera. He was the only driver to turn a lap in the 1:28 range.

Currently 2nd in the championship, Karam has won two races this year, scored eight podium finishes and sits

second in the championship. And, having won Race 2 on the GP3R street circuit in Trois-Rivières three weeks ago, he comes to Baltimore with a winner's momentum.

Finnish racer Petri Suvanto, who finished 2nd here last year in the USF2000 National Championship Powered by Mazda, set the second-quick time of 1.29.045 in the #81 Team Pelfrey / Mazda Road to Indy Mazda. Currently 6th in the championship with three podium finishes and six top-5s, Suvanto was the 2011 USF2000 champion and is racing in Star Mazda this season with scholarship funding from the Mazda Road to Indy. Third quick in the session was Suvanto's Team Pelfrey teammate and current championship points leader Jack Hawksworth with a lap of 1:29.185 in the #82 Team Pelfrey / TORGOEN Swiss Watches / EXA Networks Mazda.

Rounding out the top-5 were Connor De Phillippi with a 1:29.911 in the #2 Juncos Racing / ModSpace Racing / One24 Mazda and Zach Veach, who turned a 1:29.998 in his #77 Andretti Autosport / K12 / Zakosi Data Backup Mazda.





























Star Mazda on-track action at the Indy Grand Prix of Baltimore continues with qualifying for the PEAK Performance pole for Saturday's Race 1 from 1:55 pm -- 2:25 pm. Race 1, scheduled for 305 minutes, will take the green light for the series' spectacular F1-style standing start 2:35 pm on Saturday, Sept. 1. Race 2, a 40 minute contest with the starting grid determined by each car's fastest lap on Race 1, takes the green at 11:35 am on Sunday, Sept 2.

The Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear is a part of the Mazda Road to Indy, the official driver development program for IndyCar. The 2012 schedule includes 17 races on 10 weekends, most with IndyCar. Rising stars from around the world are competing on road courses, street circuits and ovals in front of more than a million fans as they compete for prizes valued at \$1.2 million, including a scholarship to move up and race in the 2013 Firestone Indy Lights series. Drivers 16 and older are welcome to compete and the Star Mazda Championship also features the Expert Series for drivers 30 and older. The Star Mazda Championship features standing starts, wheel-to-wheel racing at 160 mph and budgets a fraction of other top open-wheel ladder series.
