

CHAVES QUICK IN STAR MAZDA WEDNESDAY PRACTICE SESSION 1 AT PETIT LE MANS

Road Atlanta / October 17, 2012 – After turning the 2nd-fast times in both sessions at yesterdays Promoter Test Day, Colombian racer Gabby Chaves topped the time sheet in Wednesday morning's first



official practice session for the season finale of the 2012 Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear during the Petit Le Mans at Road Atlanta. His lap of 1:18.830 in the #19 JDC Motorsports / CLARO / Marca Colombia / Tecpro Mazda is just half a second off the Star Mazda track record of 1:18.328 set by Peter Dempsey in 2008. Chaves was also the only driver in the 18s – second-

quick Sage Karam turned a lap of 1:19.233 in his #88 Andretti Autosport / Comfort Revolution Mazda.

Finnish racer Petri Suvanto, 5th-quick yesterday, moved up to third with a lap of 1:19.378 in the #81 Team Pelfrey / Mazda Road to Indy Mazda. Suvanto, the 2011 USF2000 champion, is racing this year in Star Mazda with scholarship funding from the Mazda Road to Indy, the official driver development of IndyCar.

The two new drivers in the field making their Star Mazda debut here this weekend, Colorado racer Scott Anderson in the #16 JDC Motorsports / Laser Nail Centers / Neuropathy Testing Centers Mazda and Cali, Colombia driver Juan Camilo Acosta in the #97 Team GDT / STF Group / Studio F Mazda both showed marked improvement. Scott moved up from 9th and a lap of 1:20.658 yesterday to 7th and a lap of 1:20.073 this morning. And Acosta, who brought up the tail end of both sessions yesterday with a best lap of 1:22.987, found 1.5 seconds in this morning's session and moved up to 15th with a lap of 1:21.254.

Star Mazda on-track action at the Petit Le Mans weekend on Road Atlanta's 2.54-mile (4.088 km), 12-turn road course continues with an afternoon session at 4:15 pm. Qualifying for the PEAK Performance Pole Award takes place at 12:15 pm, Thursday, Oct. 18, with all the drivers aiming to the Star Mazda track record of 1:18.328 set by Peter Dempsey in 2008. The 2012 season finale of the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear is scheduled for 50 minutes and will take the green light for the series' spectacular F1-style standing start at 3:45 Friday, Oct. 19.

Star Mazda Championship cars all carry two Replay XD1080 cameras to provide exciting driver POV footage for races that are part of the Mazda Motorsports Hour broadcast tape-delayed on Discovery's Velocity Channel in the U.S. and globally on ESPN International. Drivers 16 and older are welcome to compete and the Star Mazda Championship also features the Expert Series for drivers 30 and older. The Star Mazda Championship features standing starts, wheel-to-wheel racing at 160 mph and budgets a fraction of other top open-wheel ladder series.
